



Youth Consultation Action Plan for Youth Services

The Context:

The Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth is developing a new Action Plan for Youth Services to support strategic youth service development and to ensure that young people in Ireland are able to benefit from high-quality youth work and related leisure-time youth development opportunities.

It is critical that the new Action Plan for Youth Services is informed by the views of young people. NYCI and ETBI are working together to hear from young people currently involved in youth services to bring your voice to the Department.

The Ask:

We want to hear from young people who are experiencing youth work right now and we would appreciate if youth workers would support us to harvest their views and make sure that their voice comes into this process loud and clear.

The Proposals:

Reality Check! – We know that models and modes of youth work are shifting during the summer months and we absolutely understand that his might represent a challenge in terms of engagement on this.

Option 2: Do a mini session with groups to frame the context of the consultation while supporting them to get in the zone for really contributing. This would involve a short workshop which would prep the group for completing the online survey there and then.

The mini session would involve supporting the young people to really just get in the head space where they are in a position to bring their youth work experience into conscious awareness so that they can talk about its benefits, how it's organised, how it can be improved, how they are involved and what Govt need to focus on in terms of ACTION.

Action Plan for a positive future in Youth Work

Let's look at some of the elements that make up a positive youth provision. Accessible, enjoyable, inclusive, safe and empowering. A youth exclusive space, a place where there are supports and opportunities, where young people thrive, can develop their potential and become active and engaged members of society as they transition to adulthood.

Consider using the set of question cards on the page below and invite group members to pick a card and share the answer. Or develop your own which will support a group reflection of their experiences.

(This could also be a Podcast, a video, a piece of artwork! If you think your group would be inclined to do any of these please send them on to us and we will include the content!)

This could be a 10/15min session and then provide the link for the survey and people can do it individually while collectively discussing the questions if needs be.
